設問 1. 要約 (150語) [40点]

【解答例】

Airplanes are harmful to the environment and difficult to decarbonize. A small percentage of people fly. So, if flying stops, it would not change most people's day-to-day lives. But it would greatly affect the aviation industry. International tourism will be negatively impacted but local tourism could be boosted if people holiday domestically. There will be disruption to supply chains and an end to overnight packages of fresh fish, fruit, and vegetables by air. Humanitarian aid will be at risk too. However, there will be a significant decrease in CO₂ emissions. If flying stops, society will need to adapt. High-speed rail, driverless cars, ships, and airships will become essential. This will require some cultural changes such as paid travel time, working while traveling, and maximizing the journey. Better technologies will be needed to enable people to easily meet online. It is important to consider other ways of travel for the sake of our planet. (153 words)

設問2. 意見文(200語)[40点]

【解答例:意見1】

The lecture talked about what would happen if we couldn't fly anymore. It looked at the advantages and disadvantages, and what changes in society would be needed. This essay will explain why it's a good idea to stop flying from three points of view: a) the current climate crisis, b) the things we already have, and c) human creativity. Firstly, global warming is causing serious problems like droughts and floods. The United Nations says this is a climate crisis and is asking world leaders to reduce the amount of CO₂ that is put into the air to prevent permanent harm. If we stop flying, it will greatly lower the amount of CO₂ we release. Secondly, if we stop flying, we already have the technology and things we need for different ways to get around, like sleeper trains, airships, self-driving cars, and high-speed trains. So, it's not impossible to live in a world without airplanes. Lastly, humans are very creative, and can make new technologies to replace airplanes. For example, when COVID-19 happened, people changed the way they worked and started having meetings online. If we couldn't fly, people would find new ways to get around because they're creative. The lecture talked about what would happen if we stopped flying and looked at the advantages and disadvantages of it, as well as the changes needed in society. This essay will explain why I think it may not be a good idea to stop flying from three points of view: a) the money we make from flying, b) people not wanting to change, and c) using cleaner fuels. Firstly, from a money perspective, we shouldn't stop flying because it would lead to job losses in aviation and tourism, hurting the economy. Also, it would disrupt supply chains, making it impossible to get fresh fish, fruit, and vegetables quickly by air. Secondly, people don't like change. For example, during COVID-19, some people resisted small changes like wearing masks and social distancing. It's unlikely they'd accept not being able to go on overseas holidays or get fast deliveries. Lastly,

stopping flying may not be the best solution to save the planet. Some scientists think we can make planes use cleaner fuels.
